At the heart of this evolution is the development of the **Harnas Eco Camp**, a new offering scheduled for completion in April 2027. The Eco Camp is designed to provide a deeply immersive experience, connecting guests with Namibia's landscapes, wildlife, and cultural heritage, particularly through respectful and engaging interaction with San communities.

As part of this transition, Harnas will gradually phase out its current standard accommodation and camping facilities over the next six to eight months.
